| <b>HB 24</b>   | <b>CAZAYOUX</b> | <b>PUBLIC LANDS/SCHOOLS:</b> Exempts West Baton Rouge Parish School Board from advertisement and bid requirements when leasing 16th section school board land for agricultural purposes  |
| <b>HB 456</b>  | <b>THOMPSON</b> | <b>SCHOOLS/PROPRIETARY:</b> Provides that schools which operate over the Internet are included in the definition of proprietary schools  |
| <b>HB 639</b>  | <b>WINSTON</b>  | <b>STUDENT/DISCIPLINE:</b> Provides an exception to certain expulsion provisions for students found guilty of certain drug offenses  |
| <b>HB 750</b>  | <b>CAZAYOUX</b> | <b>STUDENTS:</b> Prohibits unauthorized student use of electronic telecommunications devices in public school buildings or school buses or on school grounds and makes violations subject to school system disciplinary action |
| <b>HCR 37</b>  | <b>WELCH</b>    | <b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES:</b> Requests each public postsecondary education management board to adopt policies relative to providing information to entering freshman about credit card debt                                    |
| <b>HB 102</b>  | <b>BALDONE</b>  | <b>EDUCATION:</b> Requires all public high schools to offer instruction in personal financial management as a prerequisite for graduation  |
| <b>HB 103</b>  | <b>BALDONE</b>  | <b>EDUCATION:</b> Requires all public high schools to offer instruction in parenthood education as a prerequisite for graduation   |
| <b>HB 177</b>  | <b>BALDONE</b>  | <b>EDUCATION:</b> Provides relative to commitments of certain public school students and parents or guardians of certain public school students and provides relative to attendance at parent and teacher conferences          |
| <b>HB 1201</b> | <b>BALDONE</b>  | <b>SCHOOLS/HIGH SCHOOL:</b> Requires public high school students to perform community service as a prerequisite for graduation   |
| <b>HB 149</b>  | <b>LUCAS</b>    | <b>HEALTH/DISEASE CONTROL:</b> Requires students to submit proof of diabetes testing before entering school  |
| <b>HB 630</b>  | <b>CURTIS</b>   | <b>SCHOOLS/TRANSPORTATION:</b> Requires school bus attendants in certain cities and parishes   |
| <b>HB 754</b>  | <b>HUDSON</b>   | <b>SCHOOLS/BUS DRIVERS:</b> Changes operational schedule for compensation for school bus drivers by removing mileage categories and providing the same per mile rate (based on bus size) regardless of miles traveled          |
| <b>HB 790</b>  | <b>DANIEL</b>   | <b>SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES:</b> Provides eligibility for sabbatical leaves to certified school nurses employed in  |

state special schools and in city, parish, and other local public school systems

**HB 761 DANIEL**

**SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES:** Provides relative to the minimum number of BESE-certified school nurses that must be employed by city, parish, and other local public school systems

**HB 435 DOWNER**

**STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides for TOPS eligibility for dependent children of certain U.S. Armed Forces personnel stationed in La. under permanent change of station orders

**HB 98 J R SMITH**

**STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides for TOPS eligibility for dependent children of certain U.S. armed forces personnel stationed in La. under permanent change of station orders
