HB 208	FRUGE	CIVIL/PLEADINGS: Provides for sanctions for filing a pleading for any improper purpose
HB 358	BALDONE (TBA)	MORTGAGES: Requires the mortgagee to cancel the mortgage inscription (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>)
HB 429	PITRE	EMPLOYMENT: Protects employers from civil liability under certain circumstances
HB 480	R CARTER	CIVIL/ACTIONS: Reduces the preemptive period for lesion
HB 486	JOHNS	CIVIL/JURIES: Provides for limitations on jury trials
HB 491	BALDONE (TBA)	CIVIL/DAMAGES: Provides for liability of certain tortfeasors for damages (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>)
HB 521	JOHNS	CIVIL/JURIES: Reduces the monetary amount in controversy necessary to have a jury trial
HB 682	BALDONE (TBA)	MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL: Authorizes a medical review panel to consider evidence discovered through interrogatories (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>)
HB 730	JOHNS	CIVIL/JURIES: Provides relative to the availability of civil jury trials and mandatory nonbinding arbitration
HB 842	ANSARDI	CIVIL/PROCEDURE: Increases the amount required for a right to trial by jury
HB 872	R CARTER	PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE: Provides for a co-owner's right to rescind a partition in certain cases
HB 1251	POWELL (TBA)	MORTGAGES: Requires the mortgagee to cancel the mortgage inscription (<i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i>)
HB 1322	FRUGE	CIVIL/JURIES: Provides for the right to trial by jury
HB 1543	BOWLER	PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE: Provides for undivided interest in immovable property
HB 1544	BOWLER	PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE: Provides for presumption regarding the transfer of certain property
