| <b>HB 462</b>  | <b>MARTINY</b>     | <b>SHERIFFS:</b> Authorizes parish prisoners to participate in work activities on the property of certain tax exempt organizations   |
| <b>HB 484</b>  | <b>J R SMITH</b>   | <b>COURTS/CITY:</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional amount in controversy of the City Court of Leesville  |
| <b>HB 485</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>       | <b>CLERKS OF COURT:</b> Establishes the salaries of the various clerks of the district courts in the state   |
| <b>HB 577</b>  | <b>MARTINY</b>     | <b>CRIMINAL/VICTIM COMP:</b> Provides that victims of crime are not required to pay the fees associated with recording restitution orders                                    |
| <b>HB 693</b>  | <b>FARRAR</b>      | <b>COURTS/CITY:</b> Increases the civil jurisdictional amount in controversy of the City Court of Alexandria   |
| <b>HB 797</b>  | <b>MARTINY</b>     | <b>CRIMINAL/VICTIMS:</b> Defines "juvenile crime victim"   |
| <b>HB 877</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>       | <b>DISTRICT ATTORNEYS:</b> Increases the amount a district attorney may charge for collection on worthless or forged checks, drafts, or orders                               |
| <b>HB 878</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>       | <b>PROBATION:</b> Authorizes probation under the supervision of the district attorney in child support and criminal neglect cases  |
| <b>HB 1008</b> | <b>CROWE (TBA)</b> | <b>LAW ENFORCEMENT:</b> Requires the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training to establish standards for taking of fingerprints ( <b>SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION</b> ) |
| <b>HB 1089</b> | <b>McVEA (TBA)</b> | <b>COURTS/COURT REPORTERS:</b> Provides for the salary of court reporters in the 20th JDC ( <b>SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION</b> )  |

**HB 1093 TOOMY (TBA)**

**SHERIFFS:** Authorizes certain increases in the salaries of sheriffs in parishes with a population of 400,000 or less  
**(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)**

**HB 1143 RICHMOND**

**DISTRICT ATTORNEYS:** Authorizes the district attorney of Orleans Parish to reallocate funds fixed for the annual salaries of his assistants

**HB 1144 RICHMOND**

**COURTS/COURT COSTS:** Provides for court costs to fund the office of the district attorney in the parish of Orleans

**HB 1640 TOOMY**

**MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC:** Provides with respect to an additional fee charged by the office of the district attorney for suspension or renewal of a driver's license
