Remarks:

- HB 343 HAMMETT** **TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL:** Authorizes the governing authority of Tensas Parish to levy an additional sales and use tax
- HB 363 SALTER** **DISTRICTS/FIRE PROTECT:** Provides relative to the administration of funds of the Parishwide Fire Protection District of Red River Parish
- HB 370 FAUCHEUX** **LOCAL FINANCE:** (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes local governments to provide capital from certain revenue sources for industrial development purposes
- HB 422 PEYCHAUD** **HOUSING/NEW ORLEANS:** Specifies the proper address for notifying the property owner prior to a determination of blighted property which is subject to acquisition by the New Orleans Redevelopment Authority
- HB 722 DEWITT** **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:** Authorizes the England Economic and Industrial Development District (EEIDD) to make application to be designated as a foreign trade zone
- HB 852 QUEZAIRE** **BOARDS/COMMISSIONS:** Relative to the Atchafalaya Trace Commission and the Atchafalaya Trace Heritage Area, includes Ascension Parish in such area and adds a commission member
- HB 985 McDONALD** **TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL:** Authorizes the city of Bastrop to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax and authorizes a sales tax district
- HB 1087 HUNTER** **TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL:** Authorizes the city of Monroe to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax
- HB 1346 ALARIO (TBA)** **TAX/PROPERTY:** Provides that municipal property taxes in the city of Westwego shall be due and payable on March 31st of each year (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 1385 GUILLORY** **SEIZURES/SALES:** Authorizes parishes and municipalities to pay a commission to realtors who assist local governments in selling tax adjudicated property
- HB 1489 BROOME** **ADVERTISING:** Provides relative to printing and advertising for cultural, recreational, and tourism programs by the office of the lieutenant governor
- HB 1682 K CARTER** **PARISH/ORDINANCES:** Provides for the maximum penalties that can be imposed by ordinance in certain parishes for dumping trash and other substances
- HB 1685 PEYCHAUD** **HOUSING/NEW ORLEANS:** Removes provisions requiring or otherwise referring to electorate approval of community improvement plans undertaken by the New Orleans Redevelopment Authority
