(7/1/03) SB 23 MARIONNEAUX **APPOINTED OFFICIALS:** Provides for automatic removal of appointees not reapointed by a governor. SB 623 MICHOT **LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS:** Requires e-mail notification of certain reports to the legislature and provides that such reports be available electronically. SB 890 HAINKEL **CONFIRMATION:** Removes the required Senate reconfirmation for certain boards and commissions. BOISSIERE **LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES:** Provides for an executive SB 211 committee of the Louisiana Advisory Commission on

Intergovernmental Relations.

SB 6	DUPRE	ELECTION CODE: Provides for a detailed qualification form for candidates for public office to include information relative to criminal history.
SB 11	DUPRE	VOTERS/VOTING: Provides that the absentee vote of a voter who dies before the opening of the polls shall be counted.
SB 694	ULLO	CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides that candidates for certain school board and parish council offices for purposes of campaign contribution limits be designated as district offices.
SB 696	ULLO	CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides that the office of marshal for city court are classified as district offices for purposes of campaign finance limitations.
SB 926	ADLEY	PUBLIC MEETINGS: Provides procedure for the presentation and consideration of offer to sell natural gas to, or to assume operation or acquire ownership of, a gas utility owned or operated by a public body. (gov sig)
SB 687	ULLO	ELECTED OFFICIALS: Repeals provision requiring random drug testing of elected officials.
