| <b>HB 642</b>  | <b>DANIEL (TBA)</b>      | <b>RETIREMENT SYSTEMS:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for amortization of supplemental unfunded accrued liabilities of the Teachers' Retirement System of La. and the La. State Employees' Retirement System <i>(Technical Review Only) (Subject to Rule Suspension)</i> |
| <b>HB 1999</b> | <b>WINSTON</b>           | <b>PRIVILEGES/LIENS:</b> Provides a privilege for the collection of rents and fees in marinas   |
| <b>SB 22</b>   | <b>MARIONNEAUX (TBA)</b> | <b>CREDIT:</b> Prohibits the unsolicited mailing of credit card applications. <i>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</i>   |
| <b>SB 255</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>CIVIL PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for the revival of money judgments by ex parte motion.   |
| <b>SB 257</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>MALPRACTICE:</b> Includes extracorporeal therapist as a "health care provider" and defines "extracorporeal therapist" for purposes of the Medical Malpractice Act.   |
| <b>SB 290</b>  | <b>M SMITH</b>           | <b>FAMILY LAW:</b> Provides guidelines for visitation days relative to custodial arrangements.  |
| <b>SB 354</b>  | <b>MCPHERSON</b>         | <b>LIABILITY:</b> Provides for limits the liability of an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or other person for injuries or death resulting from equine activities.  |
| <b>SB 423</b>  | <b>MCPHERSON</b>         | <b>CIVIL PROCEDURE:</b> Authorizes federal court judges to perform marriage ceremonies within the state. (gov sig)  |
| <b>SB 572</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>HEALTH CARE:</b> Revises provisions limiting charges for copies of certain health care records.  |
| <b>SB 684</b>  | <b>ULLO</b>              | <b>LIABILITY:</b> Provides for civil immunity from liability for forceful entry to secure protective custody.   |
| <b>SB 685</b>  | <b>ULLO</b>              | <b>CIVIL PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for civil immunity for coroners and support staff.   |
| <b>SB 705</b>  | <b>SCHEDLER</b>          | <b>CIVIL PROCEDURE:</b> Provides that certain records of the La. Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information shall be privileged.   |
| <b>SB 802</b>  | <b>M SMITH</b>           | <b>FAMILY LAW:</b> Provides relative to the mandatory minimum payment of child support.   |
| <b>SB 844</b>  | <b>ELLINGTON</b>         | <b>FAMILY LAW:</b> Provides for the valuation of goodwill as an asset of community property.  |
| <b>SB 929</b>  | <b>HAINKEL</b>           | <b>BOATS/BOATING:</b> Provides privilege for the collection of rents and fees in marinas. (7/1/03)  |

<b>SB 947</b>	<b>M SMITH</b>	<b>FAMILY LAW:</b> Limits the liability for a pastoral counselor operating under the requirements of a covenant marriage.
<b>SB 949</b>	<b>SCHEDLER</b>	<b>USUFRUCT:</b> Provides relative to requiring security for a usufruct.
<b>SB 969</b>	<b>BOISSIERE</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE:</b> Repeals Section 3 of Act 734 of the 1999 Regular Session. (gov sig)
<b>SB 975</b>	<b>DARDENNE</b>	<b>FAMILY LAW:</b> Provides relative to relocation of a child.
<b>SB 983</b>	<b>DARDENNE</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSES:</b> Provides for termination of the parental rights of a parent convicted of sexually abusing their children.
<b>SB 1052</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>CONTRACTS:</b> Provides for the enforceability of gestational surrogacy contracts.
