| <b>HB 1483</b> | <b>DANIEL</b>          | <b>BONDS:</b> Authorizes the issuance of pension obligation bonds to fund all or a portion of the unfunded accrued liability of state retirement systems   |
| <b>HB 1760</b> | <b>LANDRIEU (TBA)</b>  | <b>TAX/TAXATION:</b> Provides for a Uniform Electronic Local Return and Remittance System for local sales tax<br><b>(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)</b>   |
| <b>SB 293</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>        | <b>TAX EXEMPTIONS:</b> Provides for Direct Payment Numbers for private, non-profit, tax-exempt organizations.  |
| <b>SB 720</b>  | <b>HAINKEL (TBA)</b>   | <b>FUNDS/FUNDING:</b> Provides for funding of a program for political subdivision and non-profit entity capital outlay projects.<br><b>(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)</b>  |
| <b>SB 952</b>  | <b>B JONES</b>         | <b>TAX/TAXATION:</b> Creates and provides for Tax Court as an administrative agency in the office of the governor.<br>(gov sig)  |
| <b>SB 1115</b> | <b>ELLINGTON (TBA)</b> | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM:</b> Provides relative to ad valorem property taxes to be paid under protest. (6/30/03)<br><b>(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)</b>   |
| <b>SB 1121</b> | <b>DUPRE (TBA)</b>     | <b>TAX/AD VALOREM:</b> Deletes certain requirements that protested taxes be used only for nonrecurring purposes, requires notice of amount in dispute, creates a rule to compel a taxpayer to state and pay tax he deems correct, and extends a July 1, 2003 termination date. (gs)<br><b>(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)</b> |
| <b>SB 1126</b> | <b>LENTINI</b>         | <b>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:</b> Changes the health insurance requirements for employees whose wages are equal to or greater than \$50,000 in order to qualify under the "Louisiana Quality Jobs Program Act". (gov sig)   |
