<b>HB 171</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE:</b> Provides for the continuous revision of the Children's Code
<b>HB 208</b>	<b>FRUGE</b>	<b>CIVIL/PLEADINGS:</b> Provides for sanctions for filing a pleading for any improper purpose
<b>HB 243</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>CHILDRENS CODE:</b> Provides for the safe haven of newborns
<b>HB 358</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>MORTGAGES:</b> Requires the mortgagee to cancel the mortgage inscription
<b>HB 467</b>	<b>PEYCHAUD</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Changes the period for redemption of certain property sold for nonpayment of taxes in the city of New Orleans <i>(Technical Review Only)</i>
<b>HB 543</b>	<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>PROPERTY/PUBLIC:</b> Provides relative to prescription of mineral rights on property acquired by certain governmental agencies and other specified entities
<b>HB 599</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL:</b> Provides relative to emergency medical services rendered on fixed platforms in territorial waters and the Outer Continental Shelf
<b>HB 604</b>	<b>DEVILLIER (TBA)</b>	<b>CRIME/CONTRABAND:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides that constitutional protection granted to personal property does not apply to contraband <i>(Technical Review Only) (Subject to Rule Suspension)</i>
<b>HB 714</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>LIABILITY/CIVIL:</b> Limits liability of certain persons providing gratuitous emergency care at hospitals
<b>HB 784</b>	<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>MINERALS/LEASES:</b> Provides for the recordation of mineral leases
<b>HB 803</b>	<b>PEYCHAUD</b>	<b>PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE:</b> Provides relative to the acquisition of blighted property
<b>HB 1073</b>	<b>DIEZ</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION:</b> Repeals certain content requirements of a petition for expropriation
<b>HB 1171</b>	<b>DIEZ</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION:</b> Provides relative to the information annexed to the petition to expropriate property by the Dept. of Transportation and Development
<b>HB 1251</b>	<b>POWELL</b>	<b>MORTGAGES:</b> Requires the mortgagee to cancel the mortgage inscription

<b>HB 1297</b>	<b>TRICHE</b>	<b>REVENUE SECRETARY:</b> Changes provisions of law regarding state tax liens, privileges, and mortgages to conform with the Internal Revenue Code and specifies that state tax liens, privileges, and mortgages prime all others
<b>HB 1373</b>	<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>ENERGY/OIL:</b> Relative to ownership of improvements permanently attached to the ground
<b>HB 1374</b>	<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>PROPERTY:</b> Relative to owner responsibility for property not used for commercial recreational activities
<b>HB 1502</b>	<b>LANDRIEU</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION:</b> Provides relative to expropriation by a declaration of taking
<b>HB 1564</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>CHILDREN/SUPPORT:</b> Provides for the authority of hearing officers in domestic proceedings
<b>HB 1676</b>	<b>KENNARD</b>	<b>CIVIL/JURIES:</b> Provides relative to jury service
