Remarks:

- HB 353 TOWNSEND RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS:** Relative to computing employer contribution rates, changes the amortization period for investment gains and losses from 15 years to 30 years
- HB 642 DANIEL (TBA) RETIREMENT SYSTEMS:** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for retirement and survivors' benefits for public employees (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 753 DANIEL RETIREMENT/SCHOOL EMPS:** Authorizes full-time reemployment of retired members setting forth requirements and limitations
- HB 760 DANIEL (TBA) RETIREMENT BENEFITS:** Requires state systems to provide a board-approved final estimate of benefits which is not subject to reduction after the member applies for retirement (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 1084 POWELL RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL EMP:** Includes certain supplements, fees, and commissions in the earnings of Hammond marshals
- HB 1188 SCHNEIDER RETIREMENT/STATE-STWIDE :** Clarifies provisions relating to employee contributions
- HB 1588 DANIEL (TBA) RETIREMENT/STATE SYSTEMS:** Creates the Louisiana Board of Pension Administration and the Public Employees' Retirement System of Louisiana (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 1625 SCHNEIDER RETIREMENT/STATE SYSTEMS:** Provides for amortization of the unfunded accrued liabilities
- HB 1677 DANIEL RETIREMENT/SCHOOL EMPS:** Authorizes persons in DROP or those continuing to work after completion of DROP to have their retirement recalculated at an accrual rate of 3 1/3% per year
- HB 1946 BEARD RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS:** Provides for method of funding the required employer contributions
