- HB 5 FAUCHEUX** **INDIGENT DEFENSE:** Deletes residency requirements for contract attorneys for indigent defense board
- HB 12 MURRAY** **HOLIDAYS:** Designates Dr. Martin Luther King's birthday as a mandatory state holiday
- HB 20 SHEPHERD** **HOLIDAYS:** Designates Dr. Martin Luther King's birthday as a mandatory state holiday
- HB 41 DOVE** **SHERIFFS:** Authorizes parish prisoners to participate in work activities on the property of certain tax-exempt organizations
- HB 44 LAMBERT** **WITNESSES/FEES:** Increases witness fees for off-duty law enforcement officers
- HB 62 HUTTER** **HOLIDAYS:** Recognizes September 11 as a state holiday
- HB 77 HUTTER** **LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS:** Increases witness fees for off-duty law enforcement officers
- HB 103 TOOMY** **CLERKS OF COURT:** Authorizes the utilization of alternative population data as a basis for determining compensation
- HB 104 TOOMY** **HOLIDAYS:** Extends all state holidays proclaimed by the governor to the clerks of district courts
- HB 119 TOOMY** **COURTS/PARISH:** Limits jurisdiction over suits filed under the Louisiana Governmental Claims Act
- HB 121 TOOMY** **COURTS/PARISH:** Limits the jurisdiction of the First and Second Parish Courts in Jefferson Parish
- HB 132 JOHNS** **WITNESSES/FEES:** Provides for compensation for off-duty law enforcement officers testifying at the mayor's court in the town of Vinton
- HB 155 MARTINY** **CORR FACILITIES/JAILS:** Authorizes the sheriff or the parish governing authority to collect reimbursement from inmates for the costs of room and board
- HB 159 QUEZAIRE** **COURTS/MAYORS:** Creates a mayor's court of the town of St. Gabriel in Iberville Parish
- HB 204 FRITH** **HOLIDAYS:** Extends all state holidays proclaimed by the governor to the clerks of district courts
- HB 209 GALLOT** **COURTS/CITY:** Provides for the maximum salary of the marshal of the City Court of Ruston

**HB 491 TOOMY**

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** Relative to training of municipal police chiefs, provides for training requirements and removes certain authority of the Law Enforcement Executive Management Institute

**HB 964 WHITE**

**COURTS/CITY:** Increases the civil jurisdictional amount from \$15,000 to \$25,000 in the city court of Zachary

**HB 973 R CARTER**

**JUDICIAL EXPENSE FUND:** Provides for a judicial expense fund for the 20th JDC
