<b>HB 135</b>	<b>LANCASTER</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE:</b> Changes the hours the polls are required to be open on election day
<b>HB 136</b>	<b>LANCASTER</b>	<b>ELECTIONS/COMMISSIONERS :</b> Increases the compensation of commissioners-in-charge and commissioners who serve at the polls on election day
<b>HB 144</b>	<b>KATZ</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE:</b> Relative to when a qualified voter may cast a ballot in person, changes poll hours, expands absentee voting period, and allows qualified voters to vote absentee in person
<b>HB 774</b>	<b>WADDELL</b>	<b>ELECTIONS:</b> Relative to voting in person, changes poll hours, expands absentee voting period, and allows qualified voters to vote during a certain period prior to election day
<b>HB 130</b>	<b>LANCASTER</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW:</b> Changes the termination dates of departments and statutory entities and other time frames and dates in the "sunset law"
<b>HB 548</b>	<b>LANCASTER</b>	<b>ELECTIONS:</b> Creates the elections compliance unit in the Department of State
<b>HB 634</b>	<b>QUEZAIRE</b>	<b>TRANSPORTATION DEPT:</b> Provides relative to placement of the Louisiana Transportation Authority within the Department of Transportation and Development
<b>HB 1276</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION:</b> Creates youth services as an independent organizational unit in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
<b>HB 256</b>	<b>BOWLER</b>	<b>ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to a system of administrative law
<b>HB 650</b>	<b>PIERRE</b>	<b>ENERGY/OIL &amp; GAS:</b> Repeals provisions relative to a Unified Oil and Gas Development Regulatory Index
<b>HB 434</b>	<b>TRICHE</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/COMMISSION:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Limits service on the State Civil Service Commission to no more than two partial or full terms
<b>HB 717</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE &amp; POL:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes certain employees in the classified service to publicly express certain political positions or endorsements
<b>HB 1024</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE &amp; POL:</b> Authorizes certain employees in the classified service to publicly express certain political positions or endorsements
