- HB 1062 SALTER** **STUDENT/TUITION:** Authorizes the LSU Bd. of Supervisors to impose specific tuition and attendance fee amounts for students attending the LSU Health Sciences Centers
- HB 32 MARTINY** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides relative to TOPS high school core curriculum requirements for Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards for students who graduate from high school during the 2007-2008 school year and thereafter
- HB 487 T POWELL** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Establishes additional means for certain students to qualify for TOPS Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards
- HB 16 DOERGE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Changes high school graduation date for students who enrolled as first-time freshmen in out-of-state colleges or universities to be eligible for certain TOPS awards for use at eligible La. institutions
- HB 124 GALLOT** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Permits use of TOPS Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards at out-of-state colleges and universities under specified circumstances and provides for award amounts in such cases
- HB 202 FAUCHEUX** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides alternative eligibility requirements for TOPS-Tech and Opportunity awards for certain students receiving La. high school equivalency diplomas
- HB 211 BALDONE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides relative to TOPS high school core curriculum requirements for Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards beginning with the 2007-2008 school year and thereafter
- HB 214 FUTRELL** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Requires ACT composite score (or equivalent SAT score) of at least 21 for eligibility for a TOPS Opportunity Award beginning with 2006-2007 school year graduates
- HB 289 FUTRELL** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Establishes additional means for certain students to qualify for a TOPS Opportunity Award
- HB 296 LAMBERT** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides alternative TOPS eligibility requirements for certain high school students who graduate during the 2003-2004 school year or thereafter and do not meet specified minimum high school gpa requirements

- HB 1247 BEARD** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides alternative TOPS Opportunity Award eligibility requirements for certain high school students who graduate during the 2003-2004 school year or thereafter and do not have the specified minimum ACT/SAT score
- HB 1367 K CARTER** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Permits certain students to qualify for a TOPS Opportunity or TOP-Tech award based on student performance as a college freshman
- HB 1498 CRANE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides relative to high school core curriculum science requirements for TOPS Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards beginning with students graduating from high school during the 07-08 school year
- HB 1503 SCALISE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides relative to minimum scores on specified standardized tests that are required of certain home study students to be eligible for TOPS awards
- HB 257 CRANE** **STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Increases the membership of the Louisiana Student Financial Assistance Commission
- HB 486 McDONALD** **STUDENT/TUITION:** Relative to education savings accounts administered by the Louisiana Tuition Trust Authority, deletes requirement that such accounts must be invested in either fixed earnings or variable earnings, but not both
