HCR 179 MARCHAND

STUDENT/ASSESSMENT: Requests BESE, in collaboration with DHH, to study any unintended, negative effects on students relative to the implementation of LEAP 21

HCR 252 MORRISH

HEALTH: Creates the Naturopathic Medicine Task Force to study the feasibility of licensing naturopathic physicians

HCR 256 MJACKSON

HEALTH: Requires licensing boards and commissions and law enforcement and firefighters associations to provide their licensees and professionals access to comprehensive hepatitis C continuing education information

HCR 262 FAUCHEUX

HOSPITALS/CHARITY: Creates a task force to study the feasibility of creating hospital service districts and boards to operate and maintain certain Charity hospitals

HCR 270 BROOME

HEALTH CARE: Urges and requests DHH to study resources for community-based alternatives for long term care of disabled and aging persons

HB 1327 LANCASTER

HEALTH/ANATOMICAL GIFTS : Authorizes an oral declaration of an anatomical gift

HB 1634 GRAY

GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION : Creates the Office of the Child Advocate, under the administration of the child advocate, and provides for the powers and duties of the office and the child advocate

SB 535 IRONS

CRIME/PUNISHMENT: Prohibits the employment of nonlicensed persons who have been convicted of certain offenses in certain care facilities.

SB 562 FONTENOT

WATER QUALITY: Requires an annual license for onsite treatment system providers. (gov sig)
