| SB 424 | N GAUTREUX | TOPS: Creates a TOPS Opportunity Award based on performance as a college freshman. (gov sig) |
| SB 863 | L JACKSON | SCHOOLS: Provides for smoke-free zones in schools, property used for school purposes, community centers, and day care centers. |
| SB 435 | THEUNISSEN | TUITION: Adds Agriscience I and II to the list of sciences that may be taken as part of the TOPS curriculum. |
| SB 879 | C D JONES (TBA) | TEACHERS: Authorizes establishment of a teachers' homebuyer program and establishes an advisory panel to develop such program for approval. (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
| SCR 141 | M SMITH | FUNDS/FUNDING: Requests the president of the Louisiana Community and Technical College System to allocate \$350,000 from Carl D. Perkins Vocational Education funds to the Louisiana Agriculture Education Office. |
| SCR 35 | C FIELDS | SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS: Requests East Baton Rouge Parish School Board to follow state law and rules and local policy in reference to assignment of bus routes and in-service training of school bus operators. |
| SCR 122 | ULLO (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING: Provides approval for the Minimum Foundation Program as adopted by BESE FY 2004-2005. (Subject to Rule Suspension) |
