Remarks:

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| HB 451 | MURRAY | TAX/AD VALOREM TAX: Provides with respect to the taxpayers obligation to pay property tax regardless of notice |
| HB 658 | JEFFERSON | TAX/TAXATION:(Constitutional Amendment) Provides that any manufacturing establishment receiving an exemption from ad valorem taxes for such taxes levied by a school board shall by terms of the contract granting such exemption be required to make a payment in lieu of any such taxes |
| HB 694 | ARNOLD | TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION: Removes prohibition against extending exemption for motor vehicles to municipal taxes |
| HB 998 | WALSWORTH | TAX/OCCUPATIONAL: Provides an exemption to the occupational license tax for bank service corporations |
| HB 1130 | DANIEL | TAX COMMISSION, STATE: Requires the Louisiana Tax Commission to create a statewide ad valorem tax assessment database for publication on the Internet |
| HB 1139 | HAMMETT | TAX/AD VALOREM TAX: Provides for assessment of bank stock of certain banks |
| HB 1237 | SHEPHERD | TAX/TAXATION: Provides for repayment of certain benefits received from state |
| HB 1309 | SHEPHERD | ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT: Requires contracts or cooperative endeavor agreements issued by the state to contain a refund provision under certain circumstances |
| HB 1386 | JEFFERSON | SMALL BUSINESS: Requires qualified venture funds under the CAPCO program to make a minimum number of venture capital investments annually |
