| <b>HB 665</b>  | <b>WHITE</b>   | <b>SCHOOLS/FINANCE:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Grants the Central community school system in East Baton Rouge Parish the same authority granted parishes pursuant to Article VIII, Section 13 of the Constitution of Louisiana            |
| <b>HB 509</b>  | <b>WHITE</b>   | <b>SCHOOLS/BOARDS:</b> Creates and provides for the Central Community School Board and school system in East Baton Rouge Parish   |
| <b>HB 565</b>  | <b>FARRAR</b>  | <b>PUBLIC LANDS/SCHOOLS:</b> Makes certain provisions relative to lease of sixteenth section school lands by schools boards for hunting or trapping applicable to Rapides Parish  |
| <b>HB 566</b>  | <b>FARRAR</b>  | <b>PUBLIC LANDS/SCHOOLS:</b> Authorizes the exchange of unused school land by Rapides Parish School Board and provides procedures, terms, and conditions for such exchange  |
| <b>HB 302</b>  | <b>G SMITH</b> | <b>EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY:</b> Relative to certain distinguished educators, sets selection deadlines, requires certain notice, limits number of certain persons serving as such, and provides for return to service                         |
| <b>HB 16</b>   | <b>DOERGE</b>  | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:</b> Changes high school graduation date for students who enrolled as first-time freshmen in out-of-state colleges or universities to be eligible for certain TOPS awards for use at eligible La. institutions   |
| <b>HB 289</b>  | <b>FUTRELL</b> | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:</b> Establishes additional means for certain students to qualify for a TOPS Opportunity Award   |
| <b>HB 1503</b> | <b>SCALISE</b> | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:</b> Provides relative to minimum scores on specified standardized tests that are required of certain home study students to be eligible for TOPS awards   |
| <b>HB 257</b>  | <b>CRANE</b>   | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:</b> Increases the membership of the Louisiana Student Financial Assistance Commission   |
| <b>HB 1498</b> | <b>CRANE</b>   | <b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:</b> Provides relative to high school core curriculum science requirements for TOPS Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards beginning with students graduating from high school during the 07-08 school year |
| <b>HB 887</b>  | <b>BRUNEAU</b> | <b>HIGHER EDUCATION:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Abolishes the Board of Regents and four postsecondary education management boards and creates   |

a single board for the governance, management, and supervision of all public postsecondary education

**EDUCATION:** Requests the state Department of Education to develop school menus containing foods that will foster lifelong healthy eating habits and particularly foods containing marine-source long chain Omega-3 fatty acids

**TEACHERS/LEAVE:** Removes limit on sick leave days required to be provided to a teaching staff member who is injured or disabled as a result of physical contact with a student while providing physical assistance to a student for certain purposes (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
