| <b>HB 191</b>  | <b>FAUCHEUX</b>  | <b>WORKERS COMPENSATION:</b> Requires that misrepresentations in workers' compensations cases must be material and relevant to the injury in order to constitute grounds for denial of the claim |
| <b>HB 324</b>  | <b>RICHMOND</b>  | <b>EMPLOYMENT/WAGES:</b> Provides with respect to equal pay  |
| <b>HB 326</b>  | <b>FAUCHEUX</b>  | <b>LABOR:</b> Requires the payment of overtime calculation in a certain manner   |
| <b>HB 781</b>  | <b>HUNTER</b>    | <b>WORKERS COMPENSATION:</b> Defines necessary allegations in a workers' compensation petition   |
| <b>HB 821</b>  | <b>HUNTER</b>    | <b>WORKERS COMPENSATION:</b> Provides for civil penalties for collecting workers' compensation premium from employees  |
| <b>HB 1054</b> | <b>RICHMOND</b>  | <b>EMPLOYMENT/WAGES:</b> Creates a civil cause of action for basing wages upon an employee's gender or race  |
| <b>HB 1174</b> | <b>RICHMOND</b>  | <b>EMPLOYMENT/DISCRIMINATN :</b> Prohibits denial of employment solely on basis that applicant is a convicted felon  |
| <b>HB 1673</b> | <b>JEFFERSON</b> | <b>LABOR:</b> Use unemployment funds to help dislocated workers start business   |
