HB 274	FLAVIN (TBA)	CRIMINAL/BAIL: Sets the minimum amount of bail for certain offenses (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 362	MARTINY	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE: Provides that surety be given a receipt for fees paid in connection with defendant's surrender
HB 588	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Provides additional standards with respect to suitability investigations
HB 719	HUNTER	CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES : Provides for phone usage policies at correctional facilities
HB 951	DOVE	BONDS/BAIL: Provides with respect to amount of bail
HB 1105	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Limits sanctions for non-disclosure of misdemeanor convictions
HB 1440	SCALISE	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS: Prohibits prisoners in state correctional facilities from access to cable television and use of weight training equipment
HB 1471	FARRAR	CORR FACILITIES/JAILS: Provides with respect to notification of the escape of inmates
HB 1481	ANSARDI	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE: Provides that persons arrested for felony offenses may be required to submit to a pretrial drug test
HB 1491	TUCKER	CRIME: Provides for additional penalties for disturbing the peace on school property
HB 1579	J D SMITH (TBA)	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Exempts a licensed establishment located at a golf course from requirement of having alcoholic beverage sales permits to maintain video poker (Subject To Rule Suspension)
HB 1626	SHEPHERD	CRIME: Prohibits wearing pants below the waist
HB 1641	JD SMITH (TBA)	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER: Transfers video draw poker regulatory authority from state police to the office of the attorney general (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 1683	WINSTON	CRIME: Relative to the transportation of water from St. Tammany Parish
