Remarks:

- HCR 29 CROWE**      **U.S. CONSTITUTION:** Memorializes congress to adopt a constitutional amendment providing that marriage shall consist only of the union of a man and a woman
- HCR 133 ANSARDI**      **CIVIL/ACTIONS:** Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study certain concepts related to property law in Louisiana
- HCR 134 DANIEL**      **ENVIRONMENT/OIL SPILLS:** Expresses the intent of the Louisiana Legislature in the passage of Act No. 715 of the 2003 Regular Session
- HB 61 SCALISE**      **MARRIAGE:** (Constitutional Amendment) Defines marriage as the union of one man and one woman
- HB 665 WHITE (TBA)**      **SCHOOLS/FINANCE:** (Constitutional Amendment) Grants the Central community school system in East Baton Rouge Parish the same authority granted parishes pursuant to Article VIII, Section 13 of the Constitution of Louisiana (*Technical Review Only*) (*Subject to Rule Suspension*)
- HB 694 ARNOLD (TBA)**      **TAX / A D V A L O R E M - E X E M P T I O N :** (Constitutional Amendment) Removes prohibition against extending exemption for motor vehicles to municipal taxes (*Technical Review Only*) (*Subject to Rule Suspension*)
- HB 887 BRUNEAU (TBA)**      **HIGHER EDUCATION:** (Constitutional Amendment) Abolishes the Board of Regents and four postsecondary education management boards and creates a single board for the governance, management, and supervision of all public postsecondary education (*Technical Review Only*) (*Subject to Rule Suspension*)
- HB 1410 LAFLEUR**      **JUDGMENTS/CIVIL:** Requires the social security number of the defendant to be included in certain petitions and judgments
- HB 1464 CROWE**      **MORTGAGES:** Requires that only last four digits of social security number appear on mortgage records and notarial acts
