HB 1529	FUTRELL	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING:</b> Creates the Flagship Fund and provides for the deposit and uses of monies in the fund
HB 6	FAUCHEUX	<b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS:</b> Authorizes the parish school board in certain parishes to name a gymnasium in honor of a former school board member under certain circumstances
HB 177	MONTGOMERY	<b>COLLEGES/ADMISSIONS:</b> Beginning with the 2004-2005 academic year, exempts out-of-state persons seeking admission to any college or university in the La. Community and Technical College System from having attained a minimum ACT score (or SAT equivalent score)
HB 218	MONTGOMERY	<b>SCHOOLS/ADMINISTRATORS:</b> Provides that certain employment as a school administrator shall constitute administrative service or experience for certain purposes
HB 1122	CRANE	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES:</b> Requires students residing in on-campus housing at postsecondary education institutions to be vaccinated for meningococcal disease
HB 1562	M POWELL	<b>TEACHERS/LEAVE:</b> Removes limit on sick leave days required to be provided to a teaching staff member who is injured or disabled as a result of physical contact with a student while providing physical assistance to a student for certain purposes
HB 1427	WRIGHT	<b>BESE:</b> Provides for the issuance of vocational diplomas by BESE to certain public high school students
HB 74	BALDONE	<b>CURRICULA:</b> Requires all public high schools to offer instruction in parenthood education and provides that such instruction shall be a prerequisite for graduation
HCR 120	QUEZAIRE	<b>PUBLIC LANDS/SCHOOLS:</b> Creates the Louisiana Incentives for New Ventures and Economic Stimulation (INVEST) Commission
HCR 92	DEWITT	<b>TEACHERS/SALARY:</b> Requests BESE to adopt and submit for legislative approval a revised MFP formula for the 2004-2005 school year that provides for a salary increase of \$2000 for certificated personnel and \$1000 for support workers
HR 20	CAZAYOUX	<b>EDUCATION:</b> Requests the state Department of Education to develop school menus containing foods that will foster lifelong healthy eating habits and particularly foods containing marine-source long chain Omega-3 fatty acids
