HB 324	RICHMOND	EMPLOYMENT/WAGES: Provides with respect to equal pay
HB 776	HUNTER	WORKERS COMPENSATION: Provides that immunity from civil liability under workers' compensation law shall not extend to situations where an employer fails to provide adequate security
HB 823	MURRAY	WORKERS COMPENSATION: Requires disputes be resolved according to the medical reimbursement schedule
HB 845	K CARTER	DISCRIMINATION: Creates the Louisiana Non-Discrimination Act
HB 907	HUNTER	WORKERS COMPENSATION: Allows the director to collect data for the Medical Reimbursement Schedule
HB 1016	K CARTER	PUBLIC WORKS: Creates the High Road Apprenticeship Utilization Act to establish apprenticeship requirements for public works contracts
HB 1038	RICHMOND	PUBLIC WORKS: Creates the High Road Apprenticeship Utilization Act to establish apprenticeship requirements for public works contracts
HB 1048	GRAY	UNEMPLOYMENT COMP: Provides unemployment compensation benefits to victims of domestic violence
