| <b>HB 1414</b> | <b>CROWE</b>      | <b>DISTRICTS/DRAINAGE:</b> Authorizes increase in maintenance and operation tax for St. Tammany Parish Drainage District No. 4                                     |

<b>HB 1432 THOMPSON</b>	<b>CONTRACTS:</b> Deletes certain exemptions for local depositing authorities in a parish or municipality with a population of less than 100,000
<b>HB 1583 GRAY</b>	<b>HOUSING/AUTHORITIES:</b> Provides relative to termination of tenancy by local housing authorities and exceptions under certain circumstances
<b>HB 1610 MORRISH</b>	<b>INSURANCE/HEALTH:</b> Authorizes political subdivisions of the state to establish medical savings accounts, health savings accounts, and other similar accounts for their employees
<b>HB 1635 GLOVER</b>	<b>POLICE/MUNICIPAL:</b> Authorizes the city of Shreveport to create a citizens review board to review actions of police officers
<b>HB 1647 FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>MUSEUMS:</b> Provides with respect to the transfer of ownership of the building known as the St. John the Baptist Parish theater to the Garyville Timbermill Museum
<b>HB 1656 WRIGHT</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/WATERWORKS:</b> Exempts waterworks districts from the requirement to hire an engineer for certain projects
<b>HB 1660 BROOME</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/TAXING:</b> Removes population restrictions in definition of a local governmental subdivision relative to cooperative economic development and tax increment financing
<b>HB 1669 BROOME</b>	<b>CULTURE/REC/TOUR:</b> Establishes the Neighborhood Enhancement Program within the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism
<b>HB 1676 SHEPHERD</b>	<b>HIGHWAYS:</b> Requires the Jefferson Parish Council to set speed limits along U.S. Hwy. 90 in Jefferson Parish
<b>HB 1682 HONEY</b>	<b>CORPORATIONS:</b> Provides for quasi-public nonprofit corporation
<b>HB 1684 G SMITH</b>	<b>PROPERTY/SUBSTANDARD:</b> Authorizes St. Charles Parish to acquire abandoned or blighted property under certain circumstances
<b>HB 1691 TOWNSEND</b>	<b>LOCAL GOVERNMENT:</b> Provides relative to housing commissions in certain municipalities
<b>HCR 76 RICHMOND</b>	<b>ECONOMICDEVEL/COMMUNITY:</b> Creates a task force to study and make recommendations regarding community development and housing
<b>HR 51 ARNOLD</b>	<b>LOCAL GOVERNMENT:</b> Urges and requests the department of finance of the city of New Orleans to study the feasibility of incorporating the fifteenth ward of the parish of Orleans as a municipality within the parish of Orleans
