Remarks:

<b>HB 37</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES:</b> Provides that drug-free zone sentences shall be served without parole, probation, or suspension of sentence
<b>HB 684</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/EXTRADITION:</b> Prohibits the use of bail in extradition cases
<b>HB 783</b>	<b>GRAY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/CAPITAL PUNISH :</b> Abolishes capital punishment for any person under the age of 18 when the offense was committed
<b>HB 901</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>DWI:</b> Requires proof of installation of ignition interlock device when ordered as condition of probation
<b>HB 917</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>DWI:</b> Provides with respect to ignition interlock devices
<b>HB 918</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>DWI:</b> Provides with respect to ignition interlock devices as a condition of bail
<b>HB 1422</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING:</b> Provides with respect to mental incapacity to proceed to execution
<b>HB 1481</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides that persons arrested for felony offenses may be required to submit to a pretrial drug test
<b>HB 1491</b>	<b>TUCKER</b>	<b>CRIME:</b> Provides for additional penalties for disturbing the peace on school property
<b>HB 1527</b>	<b>ST GERMAIN</b>	<b>JUVENILES:</b> Provides relative to truancy and assessment and service centers
<b>HB 1536</b>	<b>M POWELL</b>	<b>CRIME:</b> Creates the crime of illegally discharging a firearm at a school bus
<b>HB 1604</b>	<b>CAZAYOUX</b>	<b>EVIDENCE:</b> Provides with respect to admissibility of evidence in certain cases
<b>HB 1658</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>CRIME/HOMICIDE-MURDER:</b> Provides with respect to homicide involving an aggravated battery or second degree battery
