HB 199	SMILEY	MTR VEHICLE/DEALERS Provides with respect to the area of responsibility, mandatory repurchase, and warranty requirements for marine, motorcycle, all-terrain, and recreational vehicle dealers
HB 730	SHEPHERD	COMMERCE Requires mattresses and box springs sold in Louisiana to be fire retardant
HB 735	SMILEY	AMUSEMENTS/SPORTS Provides for changes to boxing and wrestling provisions
HB 852	PINAC	PUBLIC SERVICE COMN Provides for inspection and supervision fees
HCR 92	SMITH, GARY	CREDIT/CONSUMER Memorializes congress to require financial institutions to notify consumers prior to publication of negative credit information and to allow adequate time for correction
HCR 97	THOMPSON	TECHNOLOGY Urges and requests the Louisiana Broadband Advisory Council to conduct pilot projects necessary to determine the functionality and affordability of current and future broadband technologies relative to broadband deployment
HCR 135	JOHNS	COMMERCE Creates the Uniform Building Code Task Force
SB 4	GAUTREAUX, B.	PARISHES Provides for the use of the term "parish" in the name of a nonprofit organization under certain circumstances. (7/1/05)
SB 63	DUPLESSIS	COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS Allows for dealer participation in certain finance charges.
SB 107	DUPLESSIS	BANKS/BANKING Authorizes banks to use recognized systems to provide FDIC insurance coverage for public funds deposits. (gov sig)
SB 110	SMITH, MIKE	LOANS Allows lender to charge a documentation fee in connection with certain consumer loan transactions. (gov sig)
SB 205	DUPLESSIS	DATA BASE Provides for the Database Security Breach Notification Law. (1/1/06)
SB 219	FONTENOT	FUNDS/FUNDING Repeals the authority of PSC to establish rules for the Energy Efficiency Fund.
SB 222	HOLLIS	BANKS/BANKING Authorizes imposition of an additional charge in a consumer credit transaction if the consumer makes an electronic payment.

SB 238	ELLINGTON	ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT Provides relative to economic development activities.
SB 292	HINES	HORSE RACING Authorizes a Horsemen's Workers' Compensation Insurance Program.
SCR 39	ELLINGTON	TELECOMMUNICATIONS Requests the Louisiana Broadband Advisory Council to conduct public hearings in various locations across the state to ascertain supply and demand issues relative to broadband deployment.
SCR 46	ELLINGTON	TELECOMMUNICATIONS Requests the Louisiana Broadband Advisory Council to convene a task force to develop a statewide E-Rate strategy to capture all possible E-Rate funds available to the state.
