| <b>HB 285</b>  | <b>CRAVINS, JR.</b>   | <b>RAILROADS</b> Increases the civil penalties for certain railroad grade crossing violations   |
| <b>HB 518</b>  | <b>RITCHIE</b>        | <b>DISTRICTS/SPECIAL</b> Provides relative to the Washington Parish Reservoir District  |
| <b>HB 568</b>  | <b>GREENE</b>         | <b>MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION</b> Repeals the fees and requirements for obtaining vehicle safety inspection certificates on motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, and pole trailers registered in this state                                      |
| <b>HB 661</b>  | <b>BEARD (TBA)</b>    | <b>TRANSPORTATION</b> Provides for the program for construction of state transportation infrastructure <b>(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)</b>   |

<b>HB 698</b>	<b>SHEPHERD (TBA)</b>	<b>WATER/SEWER OPERATORS</b> Requires political subdivisions responsible for drainage to develop a formula for equitable expenditure of monies <b>(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)</b>
<b>SCR 66</b>	<b>NEVERS (TBA)</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to permit safe public access to the West Pearl River Navigational Canal and to extend the date scheduled for closure until such time that an alternate solution can be determined. <b>(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)</b>
<b>SCR 69</b>	<b>THEUNISSEN (TBA)</b>	<b>AIRCRAFT/AVIATION</b> Continues the Governor's Aviation Advisory Commission. <b>(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)</b>
<b>SCR 71</b>	<b>SMITH, MIKE (TBA)</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to direct the US Army Corps of Engineers, New Orleans District, to cease using Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act to stop sustainable forestry practices in areas that have no impact on actual navigation. <b>(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)</b>
<b>SB 70</b>	<b>KOSTELKA</b>	<b>FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS</b> Extends for a period of three years the authorization for special permits for trucks hauling containerized cargo in international trade intended for export within a 50-mile radius of the Port of Ouachita. (gov sig)
<b>SB 101</b>	<b>BOASSO</b>	<b>PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS</b> Provides for the membership of the board of commissioners of the St. Bernard Port, Harbor and Terminal District. (gov sig) (2/3-CA6s43(3))
<b>SB 102</b>	<b>ELLINGTON</b>	<b>TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT</b> Re-creates the Dept. of Transportation and Development. (6/30/05)
<b>SB 208</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>SAFETY REGULATIONS</b> Clarifies certain requirements with respect to tail lamps on motor vehicles. (gov sig)
<b>SB 268</b>	<b>SMITH, MIKE</b>	<b>ROADS/HIGHWAYS</b> Provides, relative to the logo signing program, for contracts with qualified third parties to be a competitive process awarded pursuant to the procurement code. (gov sig)
<b>SB 278</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>SPECIAL DISTRICTS</b> Provides for the authority, composition, duties, functions, powers, and responsibilities of the Washington Parish Reservoir District. (gov sig)
<b>SB 333</b>	<b>MALONE</b>	<b>PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS</b> Revises membership of the Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission.
