| <b>SCR 110</b> | <b>LENTINI (TBA)</b> | <b>HEALTH CARE</b> Creates the Implementation Team of the Louisiana Commission on Decision-Making of Persons with Cognitive Disabilities. <b>(Subject to rule suspension)</b>   |
| <b>SB 78</b>   | <b>ADLEY</b>         | <b>HOSPITALS</b> Includes Bienville General Hospital in the definition of rural hospital.   |
| <b>SB 189</b>  | <b>BROOME</b>        | <b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Provides for disclosure by those who provide information or recommend food, dietary supplements and homeopathic remedies.  |
| <b>SB 223</b>  | <b>HOLLIS</b>        | <b>PHYSICIANS</b> Allows a professional medical corporation to include the practice of podiatry.  |
| <b>SB 230</b>  | <b>SCHEDLER</b>      | <b>HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT</b> Provides relative to pain management clinics.  |
| <b>SB 243</b>  | <b>MOUNT</b>         | <b>CHILDREN</b> Provides definition of "neglect" relative to child in need of care.   |
| <b>SB 245</b>  | <b>SCHEDLER</b>      | <b>HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT</b> Provides for licensing of and a moratorium on facilities known as pain management clinics.   |
| <b>SB 266</b>  | <b>JONES</b>         | <b>HUMAN DEVELOPMENT</b> Provides for establishment of comprehensive program to combat poverty.   |
