HB 20	STRAIN	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Prohibits the production, manufacture, and distribution of hallucinogenic plant products
HB 56	KATZ	CRIME Creates the crime of human trafficking
HB 228	JEFFERSON	CRIMINAL/EXTRADITION Provides with respect to bail in extradition cases
HB 276	BALDONE	CRIME Creates the crime of disposal of property with fraudulent intent
HB 282	GEYMANN	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides with respect to the expungement of juvenile records
HB 330	HUNTER	CRIMINAL/HABIT OFFENDERS Provides with respect to the habitual offender law
HB 371	WOOTON	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER Amends provisions of law regarding the licensing and operation of video draw poker devices
HB 451	GEYMANN	CRIMINAL/BAIL Sets the minimum amount of bail for certain sex offenses
HB 454	RICHMOND	PAROLE Provides with respect to curfew restrictions on parolees
HB 511	HUTTER	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for authority to fix bail and grant parole
HB 525	HEATON	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Reduces length of time convicted drug offenders must be incarcerated to be considered for review by the risk review panel
