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| HCR 1 | FARRAR | SANITARY CODE Provides with respect to manufacturer's endorsements |
| HCR 82 | GRAY | CHILDREN/FOSTER CARE Requests the House and Senate committees on health and welfare to study the current laws and regulations governing children in foster care in the state |
| HCR 83 | STRAIN | DENTISTRY/DENTISTS Directs the Louisiana State Board of Dentistry to formulate proposed legislation for a volunteer license, which would allow retired dentists to practice at nonprofit health care facilities for no remuneration |
| HCR 87 | TUCKER | MEDICAID Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the feasibility of placing a cap, equivalent to the average annual cost of a private ICF/MR, on the NOW waiver |
| HCR 96 | DOERGE | CHILDREN/CARE Requests the Department of Social Services to promulgate rules and regulations to provide for the licensure of after-school enrichment programs |
| HCR 98 | BADON (TBA) | HEALTH Requests a study of the feasibility and effectiveness of a prescription monitoring program for controlled dangerous substances

HCR 105 WINSTON	CHILDREN Continues the Task Force on Legal Representation in Child Protection Cases
HB 242 CROWE	ABORTION Provides for mandatory professional counseling in all cases when an abortion is sought
HB 293 TUCKER	HEALTH Creates the Parkinson's Disease Registry
HB 333 SHEPHERD (TBA)	OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS Authorizes physician assistants to refer patients to occupational therapists (Subject to rule suspension)
HB 463 MARCHAND	SOCIAL SERVICES DEPT Provides for reinspection fees for child and adult care facilities licensed by the Department of Social Services
HB 734 GUILLORY, M.	ELDERLY Requires federal criminal history checks and elder abuse training for nonlicensed persons and licensed ambulance personnel
HB 740 HEBERT	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Exempts polysomnographic health professionals from respiratory therapist licensure requirements and recognizes polysomnography as a separate and distinct profession
HB 753 DURAND	PHARMACISTS Amends provisions of the Pharmacy Practice Act
HB 759 BURNS	HEARING AID DEALERS Provides for the Louisiana Board for Hearing Aid Dealers
HB 774 JACKSON, M.	HEALTH CARE/RECORDS Creates the Health Care Consumer's Right to Know Act
HB 816 JOHNS	PHARMACISTS Revises the fee schedule in the Pharmacy Practice Act
