| HCR 22 | JEFFERSON | VOTING/REGISTRATION Directs the Louisiana Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to create a system to notify those convicted of a felony who have completed their terms of confinement or parole relative to reinstatement of voter registration |
| HCR 118 | CROWE | CLERKS OF COURT Requests the clerks of court to remove social security numbers from documents in the mortgage and conveyance records prior to making such documents available on the Internet |
| HB 7 | GUILLORY, M. | COURTS/CITY Increases the jurisdictional amount of the City Court of Eunice |
| HB 76 | MARCHAND | INSURERS Increases the fee on premiums for commercial surety underwriters who write criminal bail bonds in Orleans Parish |
| HB 102 | BRUCE | JUDICIAL EXPENSE FUND Provides for payment of leases of judges' vehicles in 11 th JDC from the court's judicial expense fund |
| HB 107 | FRITH | COURTS/MAYORS Increases court costs for the mayor's court in the town of Erath |
| HB 135 | CROWE | COURTS/CITY Provides with respect to jurisdictional limits for the City Court of Slidell |
| HB 343 | TOOMY | JUDGES Provides for the compensation of judges |
| HB 455 | DORSEY | ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES Requires the labeling of frozen drink dispensing devices to show the trademarked alcohol brands |
| HB 633 | HEBERT | CLERKS OF COURT Provides for an increase in salary for the various clerks of the district courts |
| HB 642 | JEFFERSON | SCHOOLS/BOARDS Relative to School Violence Prevention Training Program |
| HB 711 | MORRELL | LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS Provides relative to information retained in the personnel files of police officers |
| HB 754 | HEBERT | ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES To redefine "package house", to provide for suitability for an alcoholic beverage permit, and to repeal provisions pertaining to pool and billiards playing by minors |
| HB 780 | SHEPHERD | COURTS/DISTRICT Repeals the authority of the commissioners having criminal jurisdiction in the 24 th JDC (Jefferson Parish) to accept pleas on misdemeanor charges and to have contempt of court powers |

| HB 869 | FRITH | ANIMALS/LIVESTOCK Provides relative to fees for securing livestock |
| SCR 26 | ADLEY | REVENUE DEPARTMENT Directs implementation and enforcement of law on delivery sales of cigarettes. |
| SB 75 | ADLEY | COURTS Increases the jurisdictional amount of the City Court of Springhill to \$35,000. |
| SB 139 | JONES | LAW ENFORCEMENT Requires the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training to develop a training course on law enforcement interaction with mentally ill and developmentally disabled persons. |
| SB 153 | MICHOT | CLERKS OF COURT Authorizes acceptance of electronic documents for filing and recording under certain conditions. (gov sig) |
