| <b>HB 290</b> | <b>DURAND</b>     | <b>ATTORNEYS</b> Increases criminal penalties for attorneys violating provisions prohibiting paying something of value for the purpose of obtaining representation of a client     |
| <b>HB 329</b> | <b>DURAND</b>     | <b>CRIMINAL/BAIL</b> Changes the distribution of proceeds collected from bond forfeitures in the parishes of Iberia and St. Martin   |
| <b>HB 391</b> | <b>BRUNEAU</b>    | <b>COURTS</b> Creates the Consolidated Judicial Expense Fund for the civil and criminal district courts and the juvenile court of the parish of Orleans                            |
| <b>HB 514</b> | <b>BRUNEAU</b>    | <b>COURTS/DISTRICT</b> Provides for consolidation of Orleans Parish district and juvenile courts and clerks, sheriffs, and other judicial officials and officers of Orleans Parish |
| <b>HB 701</b> | <b>BRUNEAU</b>    | <b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Creates one clerk of court for Orleans Parish and provides for the abolition of certain offices and consolidation in the office of clerk of court           |
| <b>HB 747</b> | <b>CARTER, K.</b> | <b>PUBLIC SFTY/TERRORISM</b> Provides for the issuance of special officer commissions in the event of a declared emergency or disaster   |
| <b>HB 752</b> | <b>SCHNEIDER</b>  | <b>COURTS/DISTRICT</b> Provides for consolidation of Orleans Parish district and juvenile courts and clerks, sheriffs, and other judicial officials and officers of Orleans        |
| <b>HB 794</b> | <b>POWELL, M.</b> | <b>EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS</b> Requires a person requesting disaster assistance to provide identification if requested to do so by a sheriff  |

<b>HB 846</b>	<b>DORSEY</b>	<b>EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS</b> Authorizes temporary registration of health care professionals during a declared state of public health emergency
<b>HB 876</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Prohibits a judge of the City Court of Houma from practicing law
<b>HB 941</b>	<b>ARNOLD</b>	<b>RECORDS/RECORDATION</b> Requires certain certifications prior to the recordation of conveyances in Orleans Parish
