HB 641	JEFFERSON	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Relative to elections held in certain areas that have been affected by a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster, authorizes the registered voters of the affected area to vote during the early voting period at certain temporary satellite voting locations
HB 108	BRUNEAU	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides for certain prohibited conduct relative to lobbying of the executive branch
HB 109	BRUNEAU	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides for certain prohibited conduct relative to lobbying of the legislature
HB 130	LANCASTER	<b>ETHICS/BOARD</b> Provides for the composition of the nominating committee for nominees for positions on the Board of Ethics
HB 156	LAFLEUR	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Provides that legislators file disclosure statements involving certain federally funded, disaster-related contracts or subcontracts directly with the Board of Ethics in the same manner as other officials and persons required to file
HB 311	BRUNEAU	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to procedures of the Board of Ethics in conducting investigations or hearings regarding a public servant's reprisal for disclosure of improper acts of his agency
HB 547	HEBERT	<b>GOVERNOR</b> Prohibits the governor, governor-elect, and candidates in the general election for governor from taking action to influence the selection of legislative officers and legislative committee officers
HB 628	MONTGOMERY	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to a parish governing authority member or former member serving as the parish manager
HB 671	DOWNS	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides an exception to the post-service restrictions in the ethics code to allow a former member of the North Louisiana Exhibition Center Commission to be employed by the commission
HB 703	MONTGOMERY	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires an elected official who receives certain things of economic value to disclose such receipt on certain reports filed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act
HB 793	FRITH	<b>ETHICS</b> Allows an elected official to receive compensation for the completion while in office of certain work in progress
HB 977	CAZAYOUX	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides for the definition of substantial economic interest for the purpose of the Code of Governmental Ethics
