Remarks:

<b>HB 641</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Relative to elections held in certain areas that have been affected by a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster, authorizes the registered voters of the affected area to vote during the early voting period at certain temporary satellite voting locations
<b>HB 108</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides for certain prohibited conduct relative to lobbying of the executive branch
<b>HB 109</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides for certain prohibited conduct relative to lobbying of the legislature
<b>HB 130</b>	<b>LANCASTER</b>	<b>ETHICS/BOARD</b> Provides for the composition of the nominating committee for nominees for positions on the Board of Ethics
<b>HB 156</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Provides that legislators file disclosure statements involving certain federally funded, disaster-related contracts or subcontracts directly with the Board of Ethics in the same manner as other officials and persons required to file
<b>HB 311</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to procedures of the Board of Ethics in conducting investigations or hearings regarding a public servant's reprisal for disclosure of improper acts of his agency
<b>HB 547</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>GOVERNOR</b> Prohibits the governor, governor-elect, and candidates in the general election for governor from taking action to influence the selection of legislative officers and legislative committee officers
<b>HB 628</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to a parish governing authority member or former member serving as the parish manager
<b>HB 671</b>	<b>DOWNS</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides an exception to the post-service restrictions in the ethics code to allow a former member of the North Louisiana Exhibition Center Commission to be employed by the commission
<b>HB 703</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Requires an elected official who receives certain things of economic value to disclose such receipt on certain reports filed pursuant to the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act
<b>HB 793</b>	<b>FRITH</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Allows an elected official to receive compensation for the completion while in office of certain work in progress
<b>HB 977</b>	<b>CAZAYOUX</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides for the definition of substantial economic interest for the purpose of the Code of Governmental Ethics

**HB 990 LABRUZZO**

**ETHICS/LEGISLATIVE** Prohibits legislators whose immediate family members are tax assessors from voting or otherwise participating in legislation affecting such tax assessors

**HB 1016 CAZAYOUX**

**ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS** Provides for disclosure statements involving certain federally funded, disaster-related contracts or subcontracts
