<b>HB 41</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>TAX/LOCAL</b> Authorizes the governing authority of Richland Parish to levy an additional sales and use tax
<b>HB 162</b>	<b>HILL</b>	<b>TOURISM/COMMISSION</b> Increases the maximum rate of hotel occupancy tax authorized to be levied by the Beauregard Tourist Commission
<b>HB 274</b>	<b>DOERGE</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/DOWNTOWN DEVEL</b> Creates a downtown development district in the city of Springhill
<b>HB 466</b>	<b>SMITH, JACK</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/DOWNTOWN DEVEL</b> Provides for recognition of the Franklin Downtown Development District as a downtown development district
<b>HB 515</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Creates the Parish Hospital Service District for the parish of Orleans
<b>HB 516</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE</b> Provides relative to sale of property adjudicated to a parish or municipality, including provisions for the parish or municipal governing authority to provide procedures therefor by ordinance
<b>HB 519</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>TOURISM</b> Creates the Central Acadiana Tourism Development Commission
<b>HB 551</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>PROPERTY/ABANDONED</b> Provides relative to property adjudicated to a parish or municipality for the nonpayment of taxes or other charges and assessments
<b>HB 556</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE</b> Provides that certain administrative procedures may provide for the dedication, acceptance, relocation, or deletion of certain public utility servitudes
<b>HB 605</b>	<b>SALTER</b>	<b>TOURISM/COMMISSION</b> Creates the Red River Tourism Commission
<b>HB 680</b>	<b>BAYLOR</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW</b> Re-creates the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism
<b>HB 975</b>	<b>BRUCE</b>	<b>MUNICIPAL</b> Provides relative to the repair of dilapidated and dangerous structures in the village of Grand Cane
<b>HB 1040</b>	<b>CAZAYOUX</b>	<b>DISTRICTS/SPECIAL</b> Creates the West Side Parishes Retirement District
<b>HB 1116</b>	<b>GLOVER</b>	<b>MUSEUMS</b> Creates the Spring Street Historical Museum in the Department of State
<b>HB 1130</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT</b> Authorizes creation of local and regional economic development districts

**HB 1134**   **GUILLORY, E.**

**GAMING/REVENUE** Authorizes the Calcasieu Parish Gaming Revenue District to incur debt and issue bonds and other evidences of indebtedness

**HB 1157**   **BRUCE**

**MUSEUMS** Increases the membership of the governing board of the Mansfield Female College Museum from nine members to 12 members and provides for the appointment and terms of the new members
