HCR 31	ROBIDEAUX	ATTORNEY GENERAL Directs the attorney general to contact each displaced Louisiana citizen with an out-of-state address based upon the list obtained from FEMA regarding provisions of Louisiana laws which may affect such a citizen, particularly the interaction between certain income tax requirements and voter registration and voting
HB 59	KATZ	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Changes the hours the polls are required to be open on election day
HB 427	LANCASTER	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Changes the hours the polls are required to be open on election day
HB 193	LAFONTA	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Provides for the reinstatement of prior voter registration information for a voter who reregisters to vote in a parish in which he was previously registered, provided that he re-registers within three years of cancellation of his registration in that parish
НВ 354	ROBIDEAUX	<b>VOTING/REGISTRATION</b> Requires the Department of Revenue to provide certain notifications to the secretary of state and provides for challenge of voter registration relative thereto
HB 489	JEFFERSON	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Changes the voter registration deadline from thirty to seven days prior to the election
HB 490	JEFFERSON	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Provides for a voter to vote on a paper ballot if he appears at the incorrect polling place on election day but is a valid registrant of that parish who is eligible to vote in that election
HB 641	JEFFERSON	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Relative to elections held in certain areas that have been affected by a gubernatorially declared emergency or disaster, authorizes the registered voters of the affected area to vote during the early voting period at certain temporary satellite voting locations
HB 674	WADDELL	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Authorizes the secretary of state to develop and implement a pilot program for the conduct of early voting at additional locations within certain parishes
HB 818	JEFFERSON	<b>VOTING/REGISTRATION</b> Provides that a person who is involuntarily displaced from his place of residence by a guberantorially declared state of emergency does not lose his resident status if he intends to return to the place of residence

**ELECTION CODE** Makes changes in the election

BRUNEAU	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Authorizes the secretary of state to enter into agreements with other states to share voter registration information and requires the registrars to verify that applicants to vote absentee by mail are not registered elsewhere
GRAY	<b>REGISTRARS OF VOTERS</b> Provides for an annual job performance evaluation of registrars of voters and provides that any registrar of voters who receives a rating of poor shall be subject to removal from office pending a hearing
GRAY	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Extends the application of provisions authorizing registered voters to vote during early voting in other parishes
