| HR 1 | CROWE | HOUSE/RULES Prohibits a member from changing his vote beyond the legislative day that the vote occurred |
| SB 2 | THEUNISSEN | SCHOOLS Delays from 2006 to 2007 the election of school board members in certain parishes and reduces from four years to three years the terms of those elected in 2007. (gov sig) |
| SB 16 | JONES (TBA) | VOTERS/VOTING Provides for absentee by mail voting until July 16, 2006, for persons displaced by a declared state of emergency who registered to vote by mail but have not voted in person. (gov sig) (Subject to rules suspension) |
| SB 22 | SHEPHERD (TBA) | VOTERS/VOTING Requires availability of early voting at the office of the registrar in any parish with a population of 104,000 for eligible voters in a municipal election conducted pursuant to an approved emergency plan. (gov sig) (Subject to rules suspension) |
| SB 50 | JONES (TBA) | VOTERS/VOTING Applies certain absentee voting provisions for U.S. servicemen or persons residing outside the U.S. to persons temporarily displaced by the recent common disaster and state of emergency. (gov sig) (Subject to rules suspension) |
| HR 6 | CROWE (TBA) | CENSUS Urges and requests the seventeen standing committees of the Louisiana House of Representatives to determine which laws will be affected by the population shift due to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Subject to rules suspension) |
