| HB 370 | DAMICO | INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE Provides relative to Office of Group Benefits' vesting requirements for certain retirees |
| HB 437 | BALDONE(TBA) | APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT
Appropriates funds to satisfy claim for medical expenses in the suit entitled "Deborah Batson, et al v. South Louisiana Medical Center et al"
(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION) |
| HB 728 | LAMBERT | FUNDS/FUNDING Dedicates a portion of truck and trailer registration and licensing fees and taxes for roads in the state highway system which are ineligible for federal assistance |
| HB 826 | BALDONE (TBA) | PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS Provides for a request for qualifications process for professional services (SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION) |
| HB 899 | ALARIO | FUNDS/FUNDING Increases supplemental pay for firemen, police officers, and law enforcement officers employed by police agencies of the state or its political subdivisions within certain municipalities and deputy sheriffs who have completed at least one year of service |
| HB 925 | WALKER | STATE AGENCIES Authorizes the creation of charter agencies |
| HB 965 | SCALISE | HEALTH Prohibits use of public funds for human cloning |
| HB 967 | MORRISH | APPROPRIATIONS Provides a procedure for submission and review of information related to proposed amendments to the General Appropriation Bill |
| HB 1031 | MARCHAND | PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE Provides relative to right of first refusal |
| SB 7 | NEVERS | FUNDS/FUNDING Conforms statutes with the constitutional provisions regarding the Agricultural and Seafood Products Support Fund. |
| SB 137 | DUPRE | FUNDS/FUNDING Provides for the expenditure or disbursement of Hazard Mitigation Grant |

Program funds.

- SB 140 ELLINGTON UNCLAIMED PROPERTY** Reduces the time period under which stocks and related items are presumed abandoned if unclaimed during a certain time.
- SB 151 MCPHERSON PROCUREMENT CODE** Provides for a small business program for information technology.
- SB 215 ELLINGTON UNCLAIMED PROPERTY** Reduces the time period under which the travelers checks are presumed abandoned unclaimed property.
- SB 358 ELLINGTON PROCUREMENT CODE** Exempts certain consulting service contracts related to acquisition of rights-of-way by DOTD from general state requirements for professional service contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 393 ELLINGTON PROCUREMENT CODE** Requires conduct of cost-benefit analysis to only those proposed professional, personal, consulting, or social services over \$50,000 and with a term longer than six months.
- SB 503 HEITMEIER PUBLIC CONTRACTS** Provides for the review process of performance-based energy efficiency contracts.
- SB 513 BARHAM GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM** Enables certain state employees and officials to continue membership in State Group Benefits Insurance Plan for payment of 100% of their premium after their state service ends. (gov sig)
- SB 545 SCHEDLER FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides for the distribution of certain collections from the sales of services. (7/1/06)
- SB 575 BARHAM ATTORNEY GENERAL** Provides for documenting and reporting contract with legal counsel to Louisiana attorney general's office.
- SB 605 MCPHERSON HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT** Provides for violations and penalties on nursing homes. (gov sig)
- SCR 28 BOASSO GOVERNOR** Requests the Governor's Office and the Louisiana Recovery Authority to provide accurate, detailed information and work papers to the legislature at least seven business days before submitting legislative instruments for approval of proposals for authority expenditures.
