| HB 1032 | MARCHAND | LEVEES Provides relative to the management of non-flood protection assets of certain levee districts |
| SB 222 | MOUNT | MOTOR VEHICLES Increases penalties for persons who allow unlicensed minors to drive a motor vehicle. |
| SB 269 | DUPRE | CONTRACTS Increases the public bid law "contract limit" until January 1, 2009 for certain projects to restore or rehabilitate non-federal levees in certain circumstances. (gov sig) |
| SB 284 | FONTENOT | MOTOR VEHICLES Denies or suspends driving privileges for a minor who does not meet certain school attendance requirements and authorizes local school boards and nonpublic schools to adopt policies to report dropouts to subject such persons to denial or suspension of driving privileges. |
| SB 612 | MOUNT | CRIME/PUNISHMENT Provides with respect to registration of sex offenders and issuance of a sex offender identification card as a predator alert system involving sex offender. |
| SB 673 | MALONE (TBA) | PUBLIC CONTRACTS Requires certain successful bidders to provide a written and notarized declaration of certain information to the public entity prior to execution of a contract for public work exceeding \$500,000. (SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION) |
| SB 723 | MALONE | PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS Terminates terms of current members of the Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission and revises the commission's membership. |
| SB 736 | MARIONNEAUX | PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS Provides for membership of the Greater Baton Rouge Port Commission. (gov sig) (2/3-CA6s43(3)) |
