Remarks:

<b>SB 10</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, N.</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides penalty enhancements for the crime of domestic abuse battery under certain circumstances.
<b>SB 133</b>	<b>GAUTREAUX, N.</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Requires participants in a "pilot" electronic monitoring program to be employed and pay fees related to the costs and limits eligibility to domestic abuse offenders and to sex offenders, but requires the imposition of electronic monitoring for sex offenders by courts or parole board.
<b>SB 248</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT</b> Provides for release of offenders on medically recommended intensive supervision when they are permanently incapacitated, physically disabled, terminally ill or requires long-term care.
<b>SB 338</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Provides with respect to rendition of judgments.
<b>SB 340</b>	<b>CAIN</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides for video games and other material harmful to minors.
<b>SB 353</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>GAMING</b> Provides for the maximum number of slot machines at certain eligible facilities. (gov sig)
<b>SB 502</b>	<b>HEITMEIER</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Creates the crime of price gouging. (gov sig)
<b>SB 523</b>	<b>SHEPHERD</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Requires registration and public notice for identity theft offenders.
<b>SB 695</b>	<b>CRAVINS</b>	<b>GAMING</b> Dedicates a portion of revenues derived from the Pari-mutuel Live Racing Facility Economic Redevelopment and Gaming Control Act to a health and welfare plan for Louisiana jockeys. (gov sig)
