SCR 6	JONES	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides for the creation of a task force to identify and locate displaced Louisiana citizens and to aid in their return to Louisiana.
SCR 20	SCHEDLER	<b>COMMITTEE STUDIES</b> Requests the Senate Committee on Environmental Quality and the House Committee on the Environment to study and make recommendations regarding recycling and disposal options relative to computers and other electronic equipment.
SCR 38	BROOME	<b>LIBRARIES</b> Establishes a group to study the implications and steps that should be taken to establish the Louisiana Virtual Library Council as a state entity.
SCR 61	CAIN	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Directs the governor to have lowered the flags flying over the State Capitol Building to half-staff in observance of the death of each Louisiana resident who is member of the United States armed forces and is killed in war.
SB 18	FIELDS	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides for a closed party primary election system for congressional offices with candidates and voters participating in a first and second primary according to party affiliation. (1/1/07)
SB 86	JONES	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Extends early voting time from Sat. at noon to Sat at 4:30 p.m. (gov sig)
SB 160	JONES	<b>INTERGOVERN RELATIONS</b> Provides for the creation of a regional alliance between Mississippi, Alabama, Louisiana and Texas (MALTS) to work together for the restoration and revitalization of areas affected by hurricanes Katrina and Rita. (gov sig)
SB 286	FIELDS	<b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Provides for the naming of the floor on which the executive offices of the Department of Social Services are housed in memory of Mia George.
SB 411	MALONE	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Requires the attorney general and district attorneys to institute a civil action against an individual who has registered to run for office in violation of the Constitution of Louisiana.
SB 427	CHAISSON	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides that when a candidate qualifies for more than one office in the same qualifying period, the last qualifying papers filed determines the office for which he is a candidate.
SB 476	CAIN	<b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Authorizes the secretary of state, upon request, to prepare certain documents recognizing the religious heritage of America.
