| <b>HCR 263</b> | <b>SALTER (TBA)</b>      | <b>JOINT RULES</b> Provides for the interpretation and implementation of Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b) of the Constitution of Louisiana <b>(Subject to Rules Suspension)</b>  |
| <b>SB 422</b>  | <b>JACKSON, L. (TBA)</b> | <b>LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES</b> Requires the establishment of a uniform system for reporting sources of revenue and expenditures, relative to judicial district indigent defender boards. <b>(Subject to Rules Suspension)</b>          |
| <b>SB 382</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>ETHICS</b> Eliminates authority for elected officials to be offered or accept gifts of cultural and sporting events.   |
| <b>SB 687</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides exceptions for certain insurance producers to serve as professional insurance advisors or producers of record to governmental entities.  |
| <b>SB 194</b>  | <b>LENTINI</b>           | <b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides for the admission of certain records within the Department of Social Services in court proceedings. (gov sig)  |
| <b>SB 597</b>  | <b>DARDENNE</b>          | <b>SECRETARY OF STATE</b> Provides means to shield address of registered voters who are victims of abuse.   |
| <b>SB 76</b>   | <b>SMITH, MIKE</b>       | <b>CORONERS</b> Provides that a legal holiday shall not limit or impede a coroner's work and provides for prompt release of the body. (gov sig)   |
| <b>SB 185</b>  | <b>SHEPHERD</b>          | <b>JUDGES</b> Provides relative to a vacancy in the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeal.  |
