Remarks:

<b>HCR 69</b>	<b>BURRELL</b>	<b>PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE</b> Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study tax sales in order to insure merchantable title of tax adjudicated properties
<b>HB 331</b>	<b>FRITH</b>	<b>ELECTION DAYS</b> Limits the dates for holding bond, tax, and other proposition elections to dates when there is a regularly scheduled statewide election
<b>HB 428</b>	<b>TUCKER</b>	<b>STATE OFFICIALS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes term limits for statewide elected officials
<b>HB 675</b>	<b>MCVEA</b>	<b>ETHICS/NEPOTISM</b> Allows an immediate family member of a school board member or of a superintendent to be promoted to certain administrative positions if such family member has the appropriate qualifications and certifications for such a position
<b>HB 1203</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Excludes pharmaceutical samples, medical devices, medical foods, and infant formula accepted by a physician or health care professional to be used for the benefit of a patient from the definition of "thing of economic value" for purposes of the ethics code
<b>HB 1205</b>	<b>ST. GERMAIN</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Changes the amount of contributions or donations that a public employee who was affected by a disaster or emergency may accept from certain not-for-profit organizations or funds within certain not-for-profit organizations
<b>HB 1236</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits an elected official or member of his immediate family or entity in which any of them have a substantial economic interest from seeking or entering into any contracts arising from a gubernatorially or presidentially declared disaster
<b>HB 1239</b>	<b>WALKER</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides for planning and zoning commission members in parishes with a population of less than 50,000 to recuse themselves
<b>HB 1044</b>	<b>HARRIS</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Provides for a thirty day extension on campaign finance reports if the candidate is on active military duty
<b>HB 1176</b>	<b>POWELL, T.</b>	<b>INSURERS</b> Prohibits certain campaign contributions made to candidates seeking the office of the commissioner of insurance
<b>HB 1197</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Limits the amount a candidate may loan to his own campaign
<b>HB 461</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Changes the day regular sessions of the legislature convene

**HB 853 LAFONTA**

**DISCRIMINATION** Prohibits discrimination and harassment in state government

**HB 1317 GLOVER**

**BOARDS/COMMISSIONS** Provides that no person who is appointed to a board or commission by the governor shall serve in such position for more than two consecutive terms

**HB 606 LAMBERT (TBA)**

**ADMINISTRATION** Requires the commissioner of administration to review the scope and number of publications produced by or at the direction of state agencies and make periodic reports to the legislature regarding reduction in the number of such publications  
**(Subject to Rules Suspension)**
