<b>HB 582</b>	<b>CROWE</b>	<b>ABORTION</b> Provides relative to the performance of abortions
<b>HB 1001</b>	<b>GRAY (TBA)</b>	<b>HOSPITALS</b> Provides for state reimbursement for certain medical care delivered by nonstate hospitals to persons evacuated from a state hospital in the event of emergency (Subject to rule suspension)
<b>HB 1235</b>	<b>LABRUZZO</b>	<b>DRUGS/PRESCRIPTION</b> Provides relative to drug returns to certain institutions
<b>HB 1243</b>	<b>FARRAR</b>	<b>ELDERLY</b> Creates a Silver Alert system for missing senior citizens
<b>HB 1255</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>COUNSELORS/SUBST ABUSE</b> Reestablishes a board to regulate addiction counselors
<b>HB 1262</b>	<b>SALTER (TBA)</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides with respect to reimbursement of prescription drugs (Subject to rule suspension)
<b>HB 1321</b>	<b>DORSEY</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES</b> Provides for the licensing of adult residential care providers
<b>HB 1324</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>HEALTH</b> Requires automatic external defibrillators in primary offices of municipal governing authorities and certain hotels
<b>SCR 32</b>	<b>NEVERS</b>	<b>HEALTH/HOSPITALSDEPT</b> Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to study and report on the state's readiness to handle a pandemic of the avian flu.
<b>SB 134</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Redefines certain terms for purposes of brain injury facilities.
<b>SB 135</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to direct reimbursement of healthcare services provided to Medicaid recipients by an advanced practice registered nurse.
<b>SB 139</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Provides for the Board of Examiners of Nursing Facility Administrators to maintain the Certified Nurse Aide Registry through an interagency agreement with the Department of Health and Hospitals.
