HCR 31	ROBIDEAUX	ATTORNEY GENERAL Directs the attorney general to contact each displaced Louisiana citizen with an out-of-state address based upon the list obtained from FEMA regarding provisions of Louisiana laws which may affect such a citizen, particularly the interaction between certain income tax requirements and voter registration and voting
HB 54	TOWNSEND	<b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Provides for the destruction of arrest records in certain circumstances
HB 253	CROWE	<b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Prohibits the use of electronic communications or other means to circumvent the provisions of law relative to open meetings
HB 354	ROBIDEAUX	<b>VOTING/REGISTRATION</b> Requires the Department of Revenue to provide certain notifications to the secretary of state and provides for challenge of voter registration relative thereto
HB 489	JEFFERSON	<b>ELECTIONS</b> Changes the voter registration deadline from thirty to seven days prior to the election
HB 791	LANCASTER	<b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Abolishes certain boards, commissions, authorities, districts, and like entities
HB 832	SCALISE	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Creates the Office of the State Inspector General in the office of the governor
НВ 927	LAFONTA	<b>ELECTIONS/PRESIDENTIAL</b> Approves the state of Louisiana entering into an interstate compact entitled the "Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote"
HB 1171	BRUNEAU	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Limits the public records exemption for the office of the governor to the executive office of the governor
HB 1317	GLOVER	<b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Provides that no person who is appointed to a board or commission by the governor shall serve in such position for more than two consecutive terms
HB 1340	GRAY	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Extends the application of provisions authorizing registered voters to vote during early voting in other parishes
