| <b>HB 416</b>  | <b>CARTER, K. (TBA)</b> | <b>INSURANCE COMMISSIONER</b> Provides for the appointment by the governor of the commissioner of insurance in lieu of election ( <b>Subject to Rules Suspension</b> )  |
| <b>HB 1088</b> | <b>MARCHAND</b>         | <b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Requires the secretary of state to include temporary addresses for certain registered voters in the statewide voter registration database for purposes of mailing information regarding elections or voting                                  |
| <b>SB 210</b>  | <b>JONES</b>            | <b>ETHICS</b> Permits supplemental compensation or benefits to be provided to an attorney who is a public employee who is participating in a law school administered Loan Repayment Assistance Program. (gov sig)   |
| <b>SB 263</b>  | <b>HINES</b>            | <b>ETHICS</b> Excludes pharmaceutical samples from the definition of "thing of economic value" as it relates to the ethics code. (gov sig)  |
| <b>SB 306</b>  | <b>JONES</b>            | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides that a former member or members of his immediate family or any entity that the former member or his immediate family member has controlling interest of a board or commission may not enter into a contract with that board or commission. |
| <b>SB 307</b>  | <b>JONES</b>            | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides that a former employee cannot for a period of two years after termination provide the same services on a contractual basis to, for, or on behalf of his former agency regardless of the parties to the contract.                           |
| <b>SB 320</b>  | <b>HINES</b>            | <b>LOBBYING</b> Excludes from the definition of "executive branch action" a licensed healthcare professional addressing the medical needs of a patient. (gov sig)   |
| <b>SB 541</b>  | <b>ULLO</b>             | <b>ETHICS</b> Permits a former employee to contract to provide sign language or interpreting services at any time with any agency, including his former agency.   |
| <b>SB 404</b>  | <b>HINES</b>            | <b>PUBLIC PRINTING</b> Provides relative to the authority of certain state entities to make exceptions regarding printed matter. (gov sig)  |
| <b>HR 2</b>    | <b>CROWE</b>            | <b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Prohibits a member from changing his vote after the reading and adoption of the Journal for the legislative day that the vote occurred   |
| <b>HR 11</b>   | <b>HEBERT</b>           | <b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides that the motion for final passage, to concur in Senate amendments, or to adopt a conference committee report on the Capital Outlay Bill is not in order under certain circumstances   |

<b>HR 12</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Requires a display that allows each member in the House Chamber to see the actual tally of votes while the members are casting their votes
<b>HR 13</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides that the chairman of a committee shall only serve as chairman of such committee for one term
<b>HR 14</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides for the membership of the conference committee on the General Appropriation Bill and on the Capital Outlay
<b>HR 31</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides for the membership of the Committee on Appropriations
<b>HCR 194</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AGCY/LAW INST</b> Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to evaluate the impact of immigration on Louisiana laws and make recommendations to the legislature
<b>SB 296</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Constitutional amendment to prohibit, with certain exceptions, legislative mandates increasing the financial burden of local school boards unless enacted by two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
