| <b>HB 56</b>  | <b>MONTGOMERY (TBA)</b>  | <b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Exempts certain purchases of college textbooks from state and local sales and use taxes <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |
| <b>HB 93</b>  | <b>DORSEY (TBA)</b>      | <b>TAX EXEMPTIONS</b> Provides that the state sales and use tax shall not apply to the purchase of college textbooks <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>  |
| <b>HB 135</b> | <b>POWELL, T. (TBA)</b>  | <b>TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE</b> Levies the Alcoholic Beverage Drink Tax on alcoholic beverage drinks collected at the wholesale level <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |
| <b>HB 233</b> | <b>TOWNSEND (TBA)</b>    | <b>TAX/SALES &amp; USE</b> Provides for a state and local sales and use tax exclusion for certain sales of hydrogen <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |
| <b>HB 241</b> | <b>BALDONE (TBA)</b>     | <b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Provides relative to an exclusion from state sales and use taxes for food purchases made by certain nonpublic schools <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |
| <b>HB 287</b> | <b>MONTGOMERY (TBA)</b>  | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for an income and corporation franchise tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid by certain barge line, towing, and other water transportation companies <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>  |
| <b>HB 358</b> | <b>TOWNSEND (TBA)</b>    | <b>TAX/MOTOR VEHICLE</b> Provides relative to the motor vehicle registration license tax on vehicles registered by persons sixty years of age or older <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>  |
| <b>HB 465</b> | <b>ST. GERMAIN (TBA)</b> | <b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Provides for state and local sales and use tax exemptions for adaptive driving equipment, motor vehicle modifications, and equipment specifically manufactured for the purpose of transporting wheeled mobility devices <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b> |
| <b>HB 521</b> | <b>JEFFERSON (TBA)</b>   | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides tax credit for and establishes the "Housing Louisiana's Workforce Tax Credit Act" <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>   |

<b>HB 543</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST</b> Requires certain building standards for certain facilities built or funded by the state
<b>HB 618</b>	<b>DORSEY (TBA)</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for a tax credit against the corporate income tax and the corporation franchise tax for employers who allow parental involvement in schools during working hours <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 690</b>	<b>BEARD</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for mega transportation project tax credit
<b>HB 703</b>	<b>JACKSON, M.</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Removes the commissioner of administration from the issuance of a credit certification letter for certain credits
<b>HB 847</b>	<b>JEFFERSON (TBA)</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME-INDIV/CREDIT</b> Provides for an individual income tax credit for certain teachers re-employed by a school board in certain parishes which have been impacted by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 866</b>	<b>BEARD</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Provides for a tax credit against state income and corporate franchise tax for investments in stem cell research operations and infrastructure
<b>HB 870</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Creates the Hurricane Recovery Capital Tax Credit Program
<b>HB 937</b>	<b>MARCHAND</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for an individual and corporation income tax deduction for services donated by certain licensed contractors to nonprofit organizations
<b>HB 955</b>	<b>LAMBERT (TBA)</b>	<b>TAX EXEMPTIONS</b> Exempts property owners in certain industrial areas from special taxes of the service district <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 958</b>	<b>BEARD</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Provides relative to tax increment financing and to expand the available tax increment financing revenues for use by the state
