| <b>HB 233</b> | <b>TOWNSEND</b>  | <b>TAX/SALES &amp; USE</b> Provides for a state and local sales and use tax exclusion for certain sales of hydrogen  |
| <b>HB 358</b> | <b>TOWNSEND</b>  | <b>TAX/MOTOR VEHICLE</b> Provides relative to the motor vehicle registration license tax on vehicles registered by persons sixty years of age or older   |
| <b>HB 521</b> | <b>JEFFERSON</b> | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides tax credit for and establishes the "Housing Louisiana's Workforce Tax Credit Act"  |
| <b>HB 543</b> | <b>BARROW</b>    | <b>PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST</b> Requires certain building standards for certain facilities built or funded by the state   |
| <b>HB 847</b> | <b>JEFFERSON</b> | <b>TAX/INCOME-INDIV/CREDIT</b> Provides for an individual income tax credit for certain teachers re-employed by a school board in certain parishes which have been impacted by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita |
| <b>HB 896</b> | <b>HUNTER</b>    | <b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Provides for funding of a program for political subdivision and nonprofit entity capital outlay projects   |
| <b>HB 921</b> | <b>LABRUZZO</b>  | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides a tax credit for purchase of computer equipment for use in medical offices located in medically underserved areas  |
| <b>HB 924</b> | <b>ODINET</b>    | <b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Provides for a state and local sales and use tax exemption for certain tangible personal property required to rebuild, repair, or replace certain storm-damaged property       |
| <b>HB 928</b> | <b>ALARIO</b>    | <b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for a refundable individual income tax credit for 25% of the amount of ad valorem taxes paid by a homeowner who claims the homestead exemption                                 |
| <b>HB 937</b> | <b>MARCHAND</b>  | <b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for an individual and corporation income tax deduction for services donated by certain licensed contractors to nonprofit organizations                                      |
| <b>HB 949</b> | <b>MARCHAND</b>  | <b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Provides for an individual income tax credit for persons who volunteer for certain recreation departments  |
