<b>HB 98</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>STATE AGENCIES</b> Clarifies the master-servant relationship in connection with liability of political subdivisions
<b>HB 259</b>	<b>ST. GERMAIN</b>	<b>APPROPRIATIONS</b> Provides Fiscal Year 2008-2009 appropriation for additional payments against the Unfunded Accrued Liability of the public retirement systems
<b>HB 285</b>	<b>SMITH, JANE</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Establishes the Afghanistan/Iraq Bonus Fund
<b>HB 396</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML</b> Provides for supplemental capital outlay appropriations for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 to provide for the construction of I-49 North
<b>HB 457</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>APPROPRIATIONS</b> Provides funding to the St. Bernard Parish School Board to assist with the payment of Office of Group Benefits insurance premiums for certain retirees
<b>HB 511</b>	<b>WILLIAMS</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Establishes the Teacher's Supplies Fund as a special treasury fund to provide for grants to elementary and secondary teachers for classroom supplies
<b>HB 645</b>	<b>LAMBERT</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Dedicates 1/20th of 1% of the state sales and use tax to the Conservation Fund
<b>HB 707</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST</b> Requires the construction of state buildings to include energy efficient measures
<b>HB 827</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML</b> Supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 for additional accelerated payments on the Unfunded Accrued Liability of the state retirement systems
<b>HB 835</b>	<b>GEYMANN</b>	<b>BUDGETARY CONTROLS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Disposition of state general fund monies in excess of the expenditure limit

**HB 882**      **GEYMANN**

**BUDGETARY CONTROLS** Restricts the transfer of monies from the state general fund for deposit into other special treasury funds

**HB 899**      **PETERSON**

**BUDGETARY PROCEDURES** Requires that the executive budget, the state budget, and the General Appropriation Bill include certain tax exemption information
