| <b>HB 81</b>  | <b>LAFONTA</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits the governor from appointing a contributor or an immediate family member of a contributor to serve on a board or commission                                      |
| <b>HB 82</b>  | <b>LAFONTA</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits persons from serving on or being employed by any board or commission under certain circumstances   |
| <b>HB 105</b> | <b>BALDONE</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to the agency of certain public servants for purposes of the Code of Governmental Ethics   |
| <b>HB 176</b> | <b>ABRAMSON</b>    | <b>ETHICS</b> Requires disclosure by certain elected officials of certain information relative to employment and appointment of campaign contributors and certain other contributors     |
| <b>HB 297</b> | <b>MORRELL</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to recusal by appointed members of certain boards in New Orleans   |
| <b>HB 304</b> | <b>MORRELL</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits members of boards and commissions in New Orleans from entering into certain contracts with the city  |
| <b>HB 430</b> | <b>PETERSON</b>    | <b>ETHICS</b> Repeals provision for recusal for members of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans and removes provisions permitting certain persons to serve on the board |
| <b>HB 774</b> | <b>WADDELL</b>     | <b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to the agency of certain public servants for purposes of the Code of Governmental Ethics   |
| <b>HB 789</b> | <b>NOWLIN</b>      | <b>ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES</b> Requires a background check on a candidate who has qualified for office  |
| <b>HB 901</b> | <b>JACKSON, G.</b> | <b>ADMIN LAW/DIVISION</b> Provides for the term of office and the selection of the director of the division of administrative law  |
