<b>HB 314</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires members of parish executive committees and state central committees to disclose certain financial information
<b>HB 340</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires certain administrators of state correctional institutions to file certain financial disclosure statements
<b>HB 390</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires members of levee boards to disclose certain financial information
<b>HB 635</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires financial disclosure by certain persons
<b>HB 648</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires members of levee boards and port commissions to disclose certain information
<b>HB 732</b>	<b>ELLINGTON</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires members of parish executive committees and state central committees to disclose certain financial information
<b>HB 762</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to recusal and participation in debate and discussion
<b>HB 842</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure
<b>HB 843</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure
<b>HB 902</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure
<b>HB 904</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Requires members of local boards and commissions with authority to expend, disburse, or invest \$1 million or more to file certain financial disclosure statements

<b>HB 933</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure requirements
<b>HB 989</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits members of boards of certain levee districts and similar entities and their spouses, immediate family members, and legal entities from entering into certain contracts
<b>HB 1171</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides an exception to nepotism provisions for the hiring of state police cadets under certain circumstances
