<b>SB 53</b>	<b>SHAW</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides that any complaint filed anonymously with the Board of Ethics shall not be investigated or addressed by the board. (8/15/08)
<b>SB 769</b>	<b>CHAISSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to the Code of Governmental Ethics. (See Act)
<b>SB 770</b>	<b>CHAISSON</b>	<b>LOBBYING</b> Provides relative to financial disclosure by lobbyists. (1/1/09)
<b>HCR 162</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>JOINT RULES</b> Authorizes any member of the legislature to request a fiscal note on any measure in the possession of his house of the legislature
<b>SB 653</b>	<b>DUPLESSIS</b>	<b>LEGISLATORS</b> Provides for a pay raise for legislative assistants and additional staffing for senators. (7/1/08)
<b>SB 365</b>	<b>DUPRE</b>	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> Provides relative to the Louisiana Environmental Education Act. (gov sig)
<b>HB 368</b>	<b>NOWLIN</b>	<b>SMALL BUSINESS</b> Creates the Regulatory Flexibility Act
<b>SB 493</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT</b> Provides for certain records of sensitive security information or critical infrastructure information of DOTD. (7/1/08)
<b>SB 232</b>	<b>MOUNT</b>	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Constitutional amendment to provide for a three-consecutive-term limit for positions on certain constitutionally-provided boards and commissions. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 233</b>	<b>MOUNT</b>	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Provides term limits for members of certain boards and commissions. (See Act)
<b>SB 596</b>	<b>SCALISE</b>	<b>APPOINTED OFFICIALS</b> Revises the laws regarding the state inspector general. (8/15/08)
